Choose from a large collection of movies and TV shows. Borrow feature films, comedies, documentaries, children's favorites, and more from within the mobile app. *(on Android and iOS only)*

## Android, Kindle Fire/HD, Apple iOS, & NOOK Tablet/HD/Color

You can use the OverDrive app to borrow and enjoy eBooks, audiobooks, and streaming video from My Media Mall on your mobile devices which run applications.

1. Download the OverDrive Media Console app from one of the following:
  - Google Play (Android)
  - [app.overdrive.com](http://app.overdrive.com) (Android/Kindle Fire/HD)
  - Amazon App Store (Kindle Fire/HD)
  - Apple App Store (iPhone, iPad, iPod)
  - NOOK Apps Store (NOOK Tablet)
2. Open the OverDrive app and follow the prompts to create an OverDrive account and login. If you're under 13, select "I am under 13 years old".

*Only newer versions of the OverDrive app will prompt you to sign in or sign up for an OverDrive account. If you don't see these prompts, move on to step 3.*

3. In the OverDrive app go to the Home menu, then tap on Add a library and type in Monticello Township Library. This will bring up My Media Mall as the Overdrive Library for Allerton Pubic Library patrons.
  - Tap the star to save My Media Mall to your library list.
  - Tap the words, My Media Mall to enter the Library.
4. Sign into My Media Mall by selecting Illinois Heartland Library System from the drop-down [select library] field, then use your 14 digit library card number and pin (last 4 digits of your phone from your library registration card) and borrow a title.
5. Find borrowed titles under your account

### In My Media Mall. You can:

- Download EPUB eBooks\* and MP3 audiobooks directly to the Over Drive app.
- Add streaming videos to the Over Drive app.
- Tap Read to open and read Over Drive Read eBooks right in your browser.

- If you've installed the Kindle reading app from the Google Play store, you can select Kindle Book (U.S. only) to complete check out on Amazon's website and send the book to your Kindle reading app.

*\*Note: If you're using an older version of the OverDrive app, you'll need to authorize your device with an Adobe ID to download EPUB eBooks. It's a one-time, free process that takes just moments to complete.*

## Amazon Kindle for Kindle devices without apps:

You can borrow Kindle Books from your library and deliver them wirelessly to your Kindle device, a free Kindle reading app or Kindle Cloud Reader.

*If you're using a Kindle Fire, Fire HD, or Fire HDX, please refer to our directions for Kindle Fire/HD devices.*

1. Use a computer, tablet, or smartphone to open My Media Mall [www.mymediamaill.net](http://www.mymediamaill.net)
2. In My Media Mall use the advanced search or search filters to find an eBook that's available in the Kindle Book format (or, look for the "Available formats" on each title's details page.)
3. Once you borrow an eBook that's available as a Kindle Book, select Kindle Book from the Download drop-down menu that appears next to the title on your Bookshelf, then select Confirm & Download. You'll be taken to Amazon's website to complete your checkout.
4. On Amazon's website, follow the on-screen prompts to "Get library book" and wirelessly deliver it to your Kindle device or reading app. You'll need to sign in to your Amazon account to complete this process. If you don't have an Amazon account, you'll be prompted to create one.

*Note: Library books require a Wi-Fi connection for download to Kindle devices. If you do not have an available Wi-Fi connection, you will need to transfer the eBook via USB.*

*Once you deliver a library Kindle Book to your device or reading app, it works like any other Kindle Book.*

## NOOK Reader for NOOK devices without apps:

The guide below is for NOOK models other than the Color, Tablet, HD, and HD+.

### What you need

- The USB cable for your NOOK
- Adobe Digital Editions for Windows or Mac
- A library card

### How it works

1. **Install software** - Install Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) on your computer to transfer library eBooks to your NOOK. You will also need to authorize your computer with an Adobe ID or OverDrive account.
2. **Browse, borrow, and download titles on your computer** - Open My Media Mall on your computer. Then, borrow and download an EPUB or PDF eBook.
3. **Transfer and enjoy** - Library eBooks will download and open in Adobe Digital Editions (ADE). From there, transfer eBooks to your NOOK with the USB Cable.

*Note: The NOOK HD and HD+ do not support transfers from ADE. If you have one of these devices, install the OverDrive app and borrow titles directly from your NOOK.*

*Once you have transferred a library eBook, you can open and read it like you would any other eBook on your NOOK.*

## MP3 Players:

### What you need

- A compatible MP3 player - MP3 Audiobooks and WMA Audiobooks (Check the manufacturer's website for your MP3 player to see if your MP3 player is compatible with DRM-protected WMA files.)
- A cable to connect your MP3 player to your computer
- OverDrive for Windows or Mac
- A library card

### How it works

1. **Install software** - Install OverDrive's desktop app on your computer. You'll need it to download audio titles and transfer them to your MP3 player. *If you want to transfer WMA titles to an MP3 player, you'll need a Windows computer. Even then, not all WMA titles can be transferred to an MP3 player due to publisher permissions.*
2. **Borrow and download titles on your computer** - Open My Media Mall on your computer and then borrow and download an audio title.
3. **Transfer titles to your MP3 player** - Transfer borrowed titles from your computer to your MP3 player using our instructions for Windows (which can transfer MP3 and permitted WMA titles) or Mac (which can transfer MP3 titles only.)
4. **Once you've transferred a title to your MP3 player, you can listen to it just like any other audio file.**
